Rebuilding Public Education

Concord High School upgrade

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild public education, the 2024-25 Budget is delivering record education funding, including \$3.6 billion for new and upgraded schools in Western Sydney. This targeted investment will ensure growing communities get access to a world class public education.

The upgraded Concord High School includes 40 new classrooms over 3 new buildings and refurbishment to existing facilities. It includes:



32 new standard classrooms and 5 new specialist classrooms and learning spaces for visual arts, performing arts and PDHPE



New front facing administration and staff facilities



Library refurbishment to create more space for students and programs





A new support learning unit with 3 classrooms



A new school hall, including canteen and change rooms

Timeline to completion



August 2024 – Early 2026

Stage 1 works will be to prepare for and start the construction of the new buildings.

Work includes:

- Installation of temporary facilities including canteen and change rooms.
- Set up of construction hoarding and boundary.
- Demolition of the existing school hall.
- Start of construction.

This will then continue through until early 2026 when the new buildings are expected to be complete.





Late 2024 – Early 2025

Stage 2 works will occur alongside Stage 1 and it is anticipated they will take place during the 2024/25 Summer school holidays to minimise impact to staff and students.

Work includes:

- Extension of existing western staff car park and connection of ramp.
- Resurface existing paving and concrete at the amphitheatre.

Once these works are complete these areas will be available to be used immediately.

Stage 3

Stage 3 will start after the construction of the new buildings is complete and admin is operational from the new building.

Work includes:

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Early 2026 – Mid 2026

- Relocation of the library admin rooms to the current school admin.
- Demolition of interior library office walls to create more space for students.
- Conversion of a staff room in Block G to a staff bicycle store.
- This work cannot take place earlier without significantly impacting the school operations.

Stage 4

Early 2026 – Mid 2026

Stage 4 will occur alongside Stage 3 and start after the main buildings are complete and students and staff have moved into them.

Work includes:

- classrooms.



 Removal of all temporary demountable classrooms and temporary facilities.

Installation of new games courts.

Landscaping of areas previously occupied with demountable


Installation of bicycle parking.

Timeline to completion





The Concord High School upgrade is being delivered in stages to minimise the impact on the school community and ensure students have maximum access to school facilities at all times throughout the upgrade.

It is expected that the new buildings will be operational for students and staff to use in Term 1 2026 with all upgrade works due to be complete by mid 2026.

Work to upgrade existing facilities in the school is expected to occur as soon as possible alongside the major upgrade to ensure students can enjoy the benefits sooner.

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Managing Construction Impacts

School Infrastructure NSW are working with our contractor to manage impacts on the local community, and in close consultation with Concord High School leadership to ensure that school operations continue with minimal disruption.





Refurbishment of existing spaces

As part of the upgrade project, a portion of the budget is planned to be allocated for minor refurbishment of selected existing spaces across the school.

This includes the minor refurbishment of the Theatrette (Block F) and selected classrooms and learning commons.

This may include new pinboards and whiteboards, painting of walls and ceilings and new carpet where required. This may vary across the existing classrooms.


To get an idea of how the refurbishments may look, we have trialled some minor refurbishments in a pilot room (see pictures to the right).

This work will be delivered by a separate contractor so that work can occur as soon as possible for students and staff to utilise these spaces.

The contractor will soon be appointed and we will be able to provide an update on the timeline and full scope of refurbishment.

Where possible work will take place during school holidays to minimise impact to the school community.


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Getting ready for construction
