

Concord High School

Works notification | 2 August 2024

A project is underway to upgrade Concord High School. The upgrade will provide additional permanent classrooms and core facilities across three new buildings, as well as upgrades to selected existing facilities.

To make way for the new buildings, the current school hall and canteen will be demolished. This requires temporary canteen and changeroom facilities to be installed. The temporary canteen facilities were installed in the school holidays and are now operational.

Temporary changeroom demountable installation Monday 5 August 2024

A mobile crane and multiple trucks will be required to deliver the temporary demountable facilities in pieces. The crane will be set up behind the school at the back of St Luke's Oval.

Delivery and installation of the mobile crane will take place from approximately 6am and should be complete before school hours. Removal of the crane will take place at the completion of work in the afternoon.

The demountable pieces will arrive by multiple trucks through St Luke's Oval and car park and will be lifted into place during school hours.

An exclusion zone will be set up to ensure safety of the school community and avoiding key break times so students have safe access to the canteen and playground.

It is anticipated there will be some additional noise created during the work, including the sound of reversing trucks.

Noise is not anticipated to have any impact on Year 12 students sitting their Trial HSC exams.

We are working closely with the school leadership at Concord High School to minimise impacts for the school community.
