Works notification | 28 October 2024

A project to upgrade Concord High School is underway. The next stage of construction involves pouring concrete slabs for the ground floor of the new buildings and stairwells.

Concrete pour Wednesday 30 October 2024

The first large concrete pour will take place on Wednesday 30 October 2024 during the usual work hours of 7am to 5pm.

During this work, there will be a continuous flow of trucks entering and exiting the site every 30 minutes to maintain the supply of concrete. Concrete trucks will enter the site via the construction entries on Stanley Street and will park onsite.

Traffic controllers and signage will be in place on Stanley Street from 6:00am to maintain the flow of vehicles and pedestrians and ensure the safety of the community inside and outside the school boundary.

Pedestrians and vehicles are advised to take extra care when walking or driving on Stanley Street and follow the advice of traffic controllers.

If you are visiting the school or dropping off or picking up students during this time, please use Crane Street and St Luke’s car park to avoid traffic congestion.

In the event of inclement weather, the concrete pour will occur as soon as possible after.

Further concrete pours are expected to take place in late November and December.
