

Condell Park High School

Planning update | September 2023

Project overview

The NSW Government is upgrading Condell Park High School. This upgrade will include fit-for-purpose learning spaces and core facilities.

Progress Update

School Infrastructure (SINSW) has been working closely with the Condell Park High School leadership team to develop a masterplan for the project to ensure the upgrade will meet the needs of the school community. In conjunction with our architect (DJRD), we have investigated a proposed scope for the upgrade to Condell Park High School that would help to meet the current and expected enrolment numbers.

After discussions with the school leadership, we will be progressing to the final stage of business case assessment in the near future. Further detail will be added to the design as the project progresses through the schematic and detailed design phases, and beyond into project delivery.

Next steps

Funding has been committed to upgrade Condell Park High School but, in order for the funds to be released for further design development and construction, a business case will be prepared for approval. The business case process provides the basis for the continued development of the project, through refinement, comparison, analysis, and evaluation, to ensure that the project represents the greatest value for money solution, while meeting the needs of the school community.

A business case to seek formal approval to proceed with the upgrade will soon be submitted. This will allow ongoing development of the design in consultation with representatives from the Department of Education and Condell Park High School, architects, planners, and design professionals.

As part of the project, there are some proposed public domain works to take place. A survey is currently available to assess support from the community for these proposed upgrades. Details on the next page.

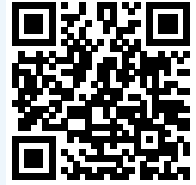
Public domain improvements

As part of the project to upgrade Condell Park High School, the Department of Education wants to improve accessibility to the school and to plan and promote programs for efficient, safe and sustainable travel. We are conducting a short survey to gauge your support to install/upgrade the following:

- Upgrade the pedestrian refuge on Third Avenue to a raised zebra crossing
- Add on-street kiss and drop zones on the eastern and western sides of the Third Avenue Entrance
- Add on-street kiss and drop zones on the northern and southern sides of Railway Parade
- Widen the southern footpath on Railway Parade between the Third Avenue entrance and Fourth Avenue
- Provide a kiss and drop area in front of the Townsend Street gate, with the potential to provide dedicated Kiss and drop spaces for support unit students.
