Condong Public School flood recovery

The NSW Government is committed to rebuilding flood impacted schools in the Northern Rivers region, ensuring we build back better with more flood resilient schools for local students and local communities.

As part of this commitment planning is underway to rebuild Condong Public School, after it was extensively damaged by floods in early 2022.

Geo technical investigations

As part of site investigations at Condong Public School, geotechnical testing is being undertaken in the school grounds during the week of **Monday**, **15 January 2024**.

The works will involve drilling and sampling from boreholes within the school site to provide information about the geotechnical properties of the riverbank at Condong Public School.

A truck mounted drill rig will be used to make the boreholes, which is roughly as loud as a commercial lawnmower.

Standard working hours are 7am to 4pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm on Saturdays.

We will continue to keep neighbours notified about major work at Condong Public School site as we finalise planning for rebuilding the school.
