

Condong Public School

Works notification | 18 March 2025

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild essential services, a project is underway to rebuild Condong Public School after it was extensively damaged by floods in 2022. The project will deliver modern flood resilient classrooms, a canteen, library, administration area and landscaping.

Temporary bus stop relocation



To enable the efficient rebuilding of the Condong Public School, Tweed Shire Council have approved the temporary relocation of the bus interchange outside the school.

From the afternoon of Thursday 27 March 2025, the bus stop will move north towards the temporary site office at 75 McLeod Street, until the school is rebuilt.

There will be no change to bus timetables.

Upcoming demolition and construction works

Now that asbestos has been removed from the flood damaged school buildings, structural demolition is expected to begin during the week of 24 March 2025 in preparation for ground works and construction.

There will be additional noise and dust during demolition, however we are aiming to complete the work safely and efficiently and will minimise impacts to the community at every opportunity.

We expect structural demolition works to be complete by 31 March 2025, weather permitting.
