Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is committed to rebuilding flood affected schools in the Northern Rivers region, ensuring we build back better with flood resilient schools for local students and local communities.

Funding for the school projects has also been provided by the Infrastructure Betterment Fund, which is jointly funded by the Australian and NSW Governments through the Disaster Recovery Funding Arrangements.

Project overview

As part of this commitment, a project is underway to rebuild Condong Public School after it was extensively damaged during floods in early 2022.

The project will deliver a raised and more flood resilient school for students and staff, with modern classrooms, a new library, canteen, administration spaces, and landscaping.

Progress summary

- Landscaping is continuing, with work underway on the garden beds at the front of the school.
- Contractors are continuing to fit out the interior of the new upstairs classrooms, library, canteen and administration areas. Condong Public School staff visited the school on Day 1 this term for a sneak peak of the new spaces.
- The lift to the first floor is installed.

Next steps

Work will start shortly on connecting the communication, security and internet services that Condong Public School will need to be operational, as well as completing the internal fit out, signage, fencing and landscaping ready for the return of students and staff.

We remain on track to have the new facilities ready for students later in Term 4 and we will provide and update to parents with a move in date shortly.
