Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is committed to rebuilding flood affected schools in the Northern Rivers region, ensuring we build back better with flood resilient schools for local students and local communities.

Funding for the school projects has also been provided by the Infrastructure Betterment Fund, which is jointly funded by the Australian and NSW Governments through the Disaster Recovery Funding Arrangements.

Project overview

As part of this commitment, a project is underway to rebuild Condong Public School after it was extensively damaged during floods in early 2022.

The project will deliver a raised and more flood resilient school for students and staff, with modern classrooms, a new library, canteen, administration spaces, and landscaping.

Progress summary

- Contractors are continuing to fit out the interior of the new upstairs spaces.
- The first-floor concrete walkways are in place.
- The lift shaft and blue stair well screenings and window awnings have been installed.
- Landscaping has started.

Next steps

Landscaping and interior fit outs are continuing to ensure the new school facilities are ready for students and staff as soon as possible. You can see the artwork for the new library on the next page.

We remain on track to complete Condong Public School in late 2025 and will work with the school on moving arrangements as soon as we can confirm a date.

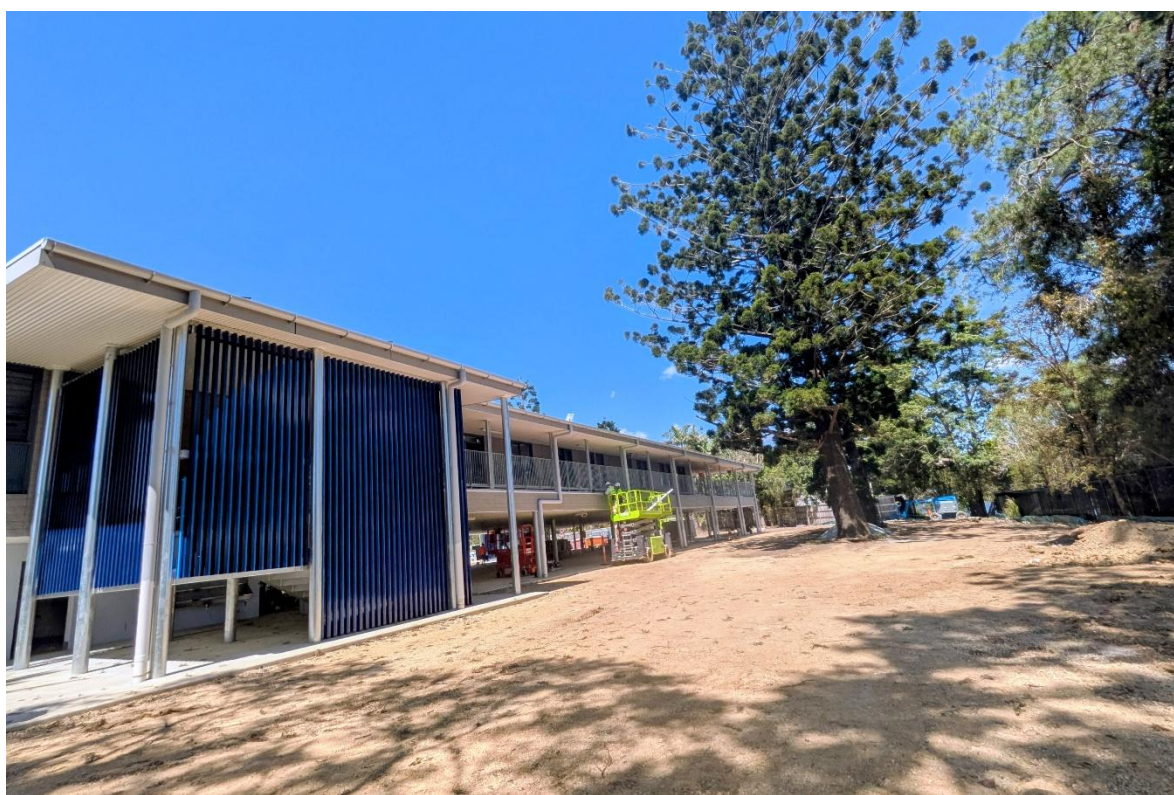
