Cranebrook High School Works notification

The upgrade of Cranebrook High School is about to begin with early preparation of the construction site starting from Thursday 5 August 2021.

The construction work will add a new building to Cranebrook High School that will host three new classrooms, a covered outdoor learning area (COLA), a shared learning space and a seminar room.

Early construction and site establishment

The Development Application (DA) to begin construction at Cranebrook High School has been approved by Penrith City Council. Crews will be on site to establish early site mobilisation and set up, this includes:

- Installing early fencing and hoarding (shade cloth) around the perimeter of where the construction site
- Installing work sheds, toiles, meeting rooms
- Establishment of erosion and sediment controls
- Allocation of construction site workers parking area.

Noise and dust control measures during the work

Noise and dust control measures will be implemented in accordance with planning approval requirements, including Densely Graded Base (DGB) spread on soil areas to suppress dust being distributed during high winds. Dust from construction works will be hosed down with water as required. Trucks entering and leaving the site will cover their loads.

We are here to make sure that work is completed safely and efficiently and we will minimise impacts on the community at every opportunity.

Working hours

The approved project working hours are 7 am to 5 pm, Monday to Friday and 8 am to 1 pm Saturday. No work will take place on Sundays or public holidays unless otherwise notified.

The health and safety of the school's students, staff and the local community is our highest priority. We will ensure that construction works will be scheduled and managed to minimise the impacts to the community where possible.
