

Cronulla High School Upgrade

Works notification | 8 December 2023

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild essential services, the 2023-24 Budget is delivering a record \$8.8 billion for new and upgraded schools. This targeted investment in growing communities will ensure working families get access to a world class public education.

A project is underway to upgrade Cronulla High School.

Demountable installation and relocation works | COB 15 December 2023 to 4 February 2024

We are providing a series of upgrades, which are planned so as to minimise inconvenience during the December/January school holidays. Please note that all external works are subject to weather conditions and the availability of licensed contractors. We will provide regular updates, especially if any work extends beyond the holiday period, ensuring the community stays informed about the progress.

Planned work:

Removal and relocation of structures:

- The work involves the use of cranes for the efficient removal and relocation of several demountable buildings and a storage shipping container from the school grounds.

Upgraded Carparks and New Pathways:

- We are enhancing the school's car parks and creating new pathways on the grounds to boost accessibility and safety.

Process Outline:

- **Site preparation:** assessing site suitability and clearing obstacles and debris.
- **Removal of services:** disconnecting utilities like electricity, water, and internet.
- **Crane installation and setup:** bringing in the necessary equipment, including cranes.
- **Safety checks:** conducting equipment inspections within NSW safety protocols.
- **Relocation and removal of demountables:** lifting and moving demountables to new locations.
- **Connection of services:** reconnecting utilities at new locations, ensuring secure and functional connections and testing operational services.
- **Final inspection:** fit for occupation.

Traffic management:

- Contractors will access the site through multiple entry points, including Captain Cook Drive, Bate Bay Road, and Elouera Road.
- Traffic control measures will be implemented to ensure smooth and safe access to and from the site, aiming to minimise traffic disruption to reduce the impact on road users and the public, some larger deliveries may be scheduled outside of normal hours.



Working hours:

- Monday to Friday: 7 am to 6 pm
- Saturday: 8 am to 1 pm
- Sunday: No work
- Public holidays: No work unless otherwise advised
- Weekend work is necessary to minimise disruption to school activities and ensure safety.

The School Infrastructure NSW office will be closed from 5 pm Friday 22 December 2023 to 9 am Monday 8 January 2024. For urgent issues during this time, contact the site manager listed on the construction site entry. In emergencies, call triple zero (000).
