The NSW Government is investing \$6.7 billion over the next four years to deliver 190 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. In addition, a record \$1.3 billion is being spent on school maintenance over five years. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

Project update

Croydon Public School is being developed to deliver new and upgraded facilities, innovative learning spaces, and provide for growing student enrolments in the area. In mid 2019 demountable classrooms were installed and design masterplanning was completed. Stage 1 construction works are about to commence.

Stage 1

In December 2019, site establishment works will start. Safety construction fencing will be erected with a site office and work sheds installed, building equipment delivered and demolition works undertaken. The heritage building on Young Street (Building E) will undergo internal refurbishment and repairs.

In April 2020, school administration and staff will move into building E and building A will undergo a refurbishment, starting on the ground floor then moving to level 1, in order to maintain access to the school library.

Stage 2

In mid 2020 construction is expected to commence on building N, subject to Development Application (DA) approval, which will provide 18 new flexible learning spaces. We also plan to upgrade or replace the building D toilet block however plans are yet to be finalised.

Site establishment and works commencement

Construction works will take place from 7.00am to 5.30pm Monday to Friday and 7.00am to 1.00pm Saturday. No work will take place on Sundays or public holidays.

In the finished project it is intended to retain staff car parking however temporary closure may be required during construction. We will keep the school community updated once we have more information from the construction site manager.

School Infrastructure will work closely with the school community and neighbours to minimise impacts where possible and ensure continuity of school operations. Notifications to the school community and surrounding neighbours will be issued prior to any work being undertaken.
