Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6 billion over the next four years to deliver more than 170 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. In addition, a record \$1.3 billion is being spent on school maintenance over four years. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

Croydon Public School

The upgrade at Croydon Public School will deliver:

- One new building with 18 teaching spaces and an additional four teaching spaces attached to Block Q
- A library, hall and special programs building refurbishment
- A new canteen
- Covered walkway area
- Covered outdoor learning area (COLA).

Project summary

The development application has been lodged with Burwood Council and is awaiting approval. It is anticipated that the construction contract for main works will be awarded in mid 2019, subject to planning approvals.

Early works

Early works commenced in mid 2019. These works include the installation of demountable classrooms, internal and external restoration works to the heritage building and minor landscaping works.

Work hours will be in accordance with Burwood Council's approved working hours which will be outlined in the Development consent conditions. School Infrastructure NSW will work closely with the school community and share regular updates as the project progresses.
