Works notification

December 2021

We are upgrading Croydon Public School with new and improved education facilities for students. We are writing to provide an update on works occurring as work on this upgrade continues.

Removal of demountable classrooms

In November 2021, we undertook works to remove a cluster of demountable classrooms from Croydon Public School.

We will now be undertaking further works to remove 6 remaining demountables from the school site.

The removal works will take place from Tuesday 7 December to Thursday 30 December 2021, weather permitting. In the event of wet weather, works may be postponed by a few days.

Works will involve using a crane to lift the demountables safely onto trucks to remove them from the site. Trucks will enter and exit the school grounds via an opening in the boundary fence on Young Street. To create the opening, we have received permission from Burwood Council to prune the surrounding trees.

Traffic controllers will be in place on Young Street during the works to manage traffic flow and ensure pedestrian safety.

Following the removal of the demountables, works to landscape the area will take place in early 2022.

Working hours

Standard project working hours are 7 am to 5 pm Monday to Friday and 7 am to 5 pm Saturday. No work will take place on public holidays, unless otherwise notified.

We are here to make sure that work is completed safely and efficiently and we will minimise impacts on the community at every opportunity.
