We are writing to provide an update on works occurring while we upgrade Croydon Public School.

Disruption to Boundary Street Traffic - Wednesday 2 December 2020

As part of the upgrade works, a concrete slab will be poured for level two of the new school building (N Block) on Wednesday 2 December from 7.00am to 5.00pm. The concrete pour will impact traffic on Boundary Street. Traffic management will be in place to ensure the disruption is minimal. See overleaf for a map of the impacted area.

- Traffic control will be on site to mitigate the high volume of concrete trucks on public and pedestrian access along Boundary Street.
- Traffic control will ensure access to residential properties is maintained at all times.
- For the safety of students, the local community and workers, road users are required to obey directions.

The disruption to traffic is required to facilitate the pouring of the concrete slab, weather and site conditions permitting. We will provide further notification if the work and traffic management need to be rescheduled.

Ongoing removal of bonded asbestos identified inside the construction site

As previously notified, bonded asbestos was identified during construction works at the school in a section of the construction site. Bonded asbestos means it is attached to other material, such as cement or vinyl floor tiles, and cannot be crumbled by light pressure. It does not pose a risk to students, staff or the local community.

Safety measures in place

Safety measures have been put in place to ensure the area has been covered and contained with appropriate control and air monitoring measures installed. Works are being conducted in accordance with the Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan and SafeWork NSW requirements.

Testing is being completed after each stage of works to ensure the site is safe for students, staff and the community. A clearance certificate, produced by a consultant hygienist after each period of works, is issued so students and staff can return to school, and work on the school upgrade can continue.

Hours of work

Weekends throughout December from Saturday 5 December to Sunday 20 December 2020 inclusive. Work will be carried out on site between 7:00am and 4:00pm. The asbestos material will be removed by a licensed asbestos removal contractor during this period, weather permitting.

Thank you for your patience while we deliver this important school infrastructure.


