Croydon Public School

The Croydon Public School upgrade aims to deliver new flexible learning spaces to meet expected demand and upgrade of core facilities including the hall, canteen, library, administration buildings and outdoor learning spaces.

Progress summary

- The refurbished hall is finished and was handed over to the School in July 2021.
- The extension of Block Q which will provide four additional learning spaces is now finished and ready for early occupation.
- Construction of the new building, Block N which will provide 18 learning spaces, is progressing well.

Next steps

- Finish construction of Block N.
- Finish external landscaping including astroturf and footpath rectification.
- Following completion of main works, demountable classrooms will be removed.
