A project is underway to upgrade Carlingford West Public School and Cumberland High School.

Use of vibratory roller on Cumberland High School link road from 23 February to 8 March 2023

As part of the works to construct the Cumberland High School carpark and link road between Dunmore Avenue and Blenheim Road a vibratory roller will be used intermittently on site from Thursday 23 February to Wednesday 8 March 2023 (weather permitting).

Vibration levels will be monitored in accordance with the site-specific Construction Noise and Vibration Management Plan, with three vibration monitors set up on neighbouring properties to ensure vibration levels are maintained within the limits. These monitors will also keep an accurate record of vibrations and will send an alert if the vibrations exceed standard practice.

Managing construction impacts

The safety of the school's students, staff, visitors and the local community is our highest priority. Construction planning is designed so there is minimal impact on school operations. Safety measures are in place to separate the construction site from areas occupied by the school and ensure students are unable to enter construction areas.
