Frequently asked questions (continued)

When are classes being relocated?

During the end of Term 1 school holidays, all classes will be relocated to the new buildings to ensure the students can use their new learning spaces from Day 1 Term 2 2020.

What happens to the canteen in Stage 2?

During Stage 2, the canteen will be operated out of a temporary building that will be located in a safely accessible area of the car park.

How will the operational area of the school be safely separated from the construction area?

The construction site will be separated with a hoarding, the same barrier that is currently being used to separate the school's operational and construction zones.

Will there be any changes to the existing bus stop locations and/or the kiss and drop location?

There will be no change to the existing bus stop locations. The new kiss and drop will be located on the southern end of Playfair Road as shown in the overleaf.

Will there be any changes to the construction vehicle access point?

Yes, the new construction vehicle access points will be on Playfair Road. There will be two access points, one on the most northern end of the Stage 2 construction zone and one on the most southern end of the stage 2 construction zone.

Will there be any change to the school entrances?

Yes. The main entrance will be on Abbot Road with a secondary entrance on the southern end of Playfair Road.

When will the demountable classrooms be removed?

The demountable classrooms will be removed at the beginning of Term 2 to make way for Stage 2 construction.

Will there be any change to parking?

Parking on Playfair Road has increased by four spaces . Parking on Saturdays and Sundays will include a restriction from 3:00pm-4:00pm in addition to the existing no parking restrictions from 8:30am -9:30am.

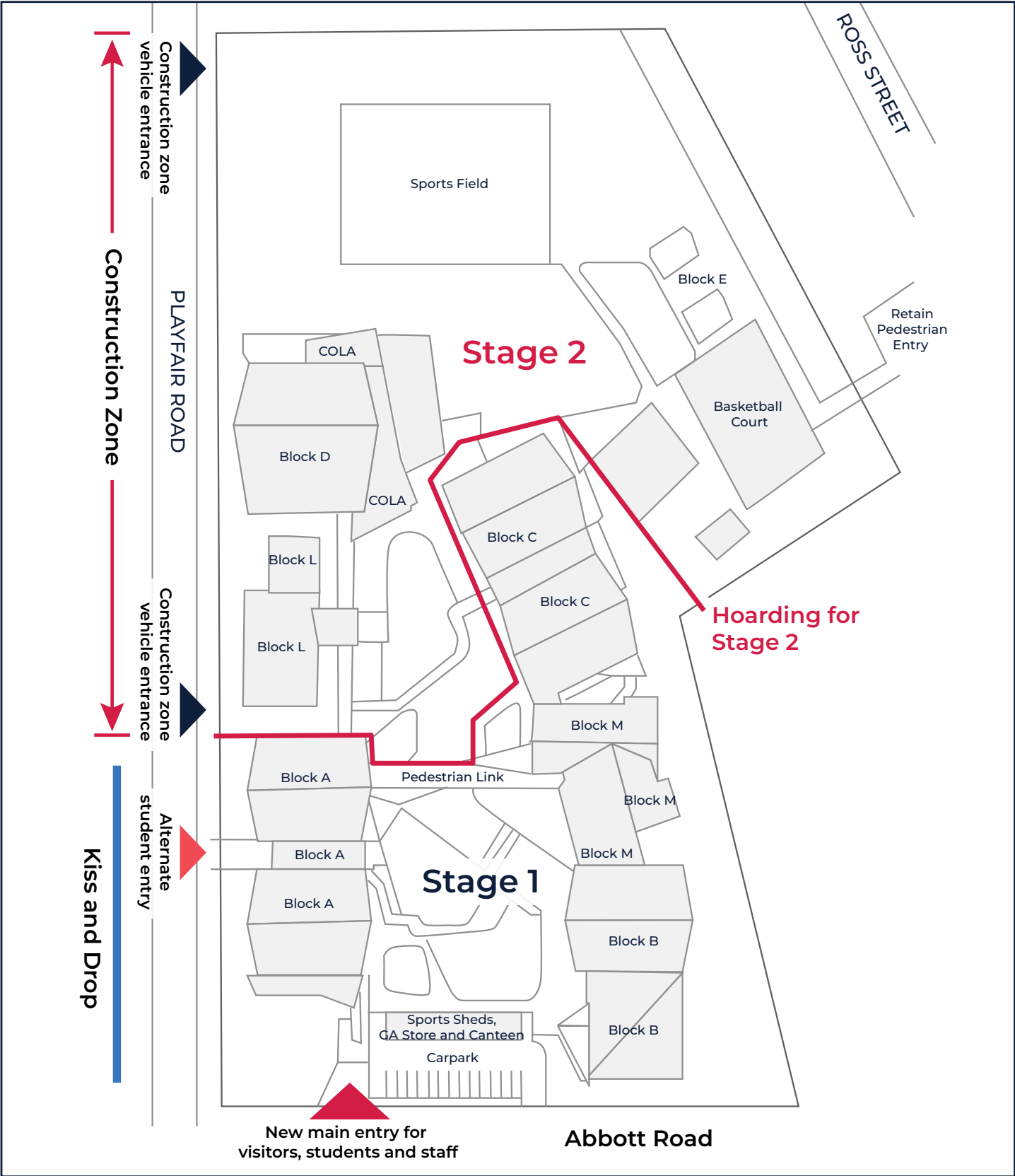
Thank you for your patience during construction. We are thrilled to deliver this project for the school community.
