### Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6.7 billion over the next four years to deliver 190 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW.

In addition, a record \$1.3 billion is being spent on school maintenance over five years. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

### **Curl Curl North Public School**

Stage one of the upgrade of Curl Curl North Public School is progressing on schedule.

The project will ultimately deliver:

- 40 new permanent teaching spaces
- Upgraded administration an core school facilities
- Library
- New School hall
- New landscaping and upgraded outdoor play areas





Remediation works for Stage one are complete and building works have started.





### **Project staging**

The project is being staged to allow the school to continue to operate throughout construction.



### **Construction working hours**

- Monday Friday: 7am 6pm
- Saturday: 7am -1pm

No work Sundays or public holidays.

\*Please note: There may be occasions where work is required outside of these approved hours, to ensure the safety of staff and students. We will inform you ahead of time of any changes to the approved working hours.

### **Next Steps**

Throughout August works on site will include:

- Formwork and pouring concrete footings
- Formwork and pouring concrete for the ground level and suspended slabs
- Works on in-ground services
- Erection of construction scaffolding

### Traffic and parking

To minimise local traffic and parking impacts, site team members will park away from the immediate school area. 'Kiss and Drop' zones will not be affected.

Deliveries to the work site will be scheduled outside regular pick up and drop off periods and vehicles will enter the site via the school's Abbott Road access.

As works progress, we will continue to share construction updates with the school and local community.
