Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6.5 billion over the next four years to deliver 190 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. In addition, a record \$1.3 billion is being spent on school maintenance over four years. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

Curl Curl North Public School

An upgrade at Curl Curl North Public School is underway. The project will deliver new permanent innovative learning spaces and an upgrade to core facilities.

This stage 1 will deliver:

- 40 new permanent teaching spaces
- A new library
- An upgrade to the administration facilities

Progress summary:

The remediation of Stage 1 works are now complete.

Stage 1 building works have commenced. This work includes all construction activities for stage 1 buildings and delivery of materials.

Traffic and parking

To minimise traffic and parking impacts, workers will park away from school and return to site on foot. Kiss and drop zones will not be affected.

Deliveries will be scheduled for outside of pick up and drop off times and will continue via the south end of the school on Abbott Road.

We will continue to share construction updates and project information with the school as the project progresses. We will provide information through information booths, project updates, school newsletters and our website.

Curl Curl North Public School upgrade

An upgrade is underway at Curl Curl North Public School to deliver new facilities, innovative learning spaces and provide for growing student enrolments in the area. The project is being delivered in stages and includes:

Stage 1

40 new permanent teaching spaces

- a new library
- an upgrade to the administration facilities

Stage 2

- a new hall
- an upgrade to external play space

Stage 3

- final landscaping
- existing hall is demolished

The project is being delivered in stages so that the temporary classrooms can be removed from site before the new hall is built.
