## Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6.7 billion over four years to deliver more than 190 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. In addition, a record \$1.3 billion is being spent on school maintenance over five years. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

#### **Curl Curl North Public School**

An upgrade at Curl Curl North Public School is progressing well and works are on schedule. The project will be delivered in 2 stages with stage 1 scheduled to finish on time for Day 1 Term 2 2020.

Stage 1 is delivering:

- 40 new permanent teaching spaces
- a new library
- upgraded administration facilities

#### **Progress and next steps**

Relocation into the new stage 1 buildings will take place during the Autumn holiday and students will move into the new buildings on Day 1 Term 2 2020. We will provide detailed information about Day 1 Term 2 2020 during the last week of Term 1.

Stage 2 works will begin in late April 2020, with the removal of demountables and the demolition of the hall and canteen. As previously communicated, a temporary canteen will be set up in a secure area of the car park during stage 2 works (see image below).

The school will have access to the Curl Curl Youth & Community Centre on Abbott Road for events and functions during stage 2 works.

The school's new electrical substation was delivered and installed during the Christmas holiday period and commissioning is scheduled in late March (weather dependent). Site construction hours are:

- 7.00 6.00pm Monday to Friday
- 7.00 1.00pm Saturday

No works take place on Sundays or public holidays.
