Curl Curl North Public School

We are upgrading Curl Curl North Public School with new and improved education facilities for students. This upgrade includes:

- 40 permanent teaching spaces
- a new hall and canteen
- a new library
- a new administration building
- upgraded playground and sports facilities.

Progress summary

Stage 2 works are progressing well. The concrete slab, structural steel framework and installation of in-ground services for the new hall, new toilets and OOSH facilities have been completed. Brickwork and roofing for the hall plus work on the landscaped ground level stormwater management system has started.

School holiday works

Over the school holidays, construction of the hall, OOSH facilities and new toilets (Block E) will continue to progress.

Landscaping works will take place including the continuation of the landscaped stormwater management system and compacting the ground for the new sports courts.

There may be increased noise, vibration and dust as a part of this work. The health and safety of students, staff and the local community is our highest priority. We will ensure that work is completed safely and efficiently, and disruptions are minimised where possible.

There are two construction vehicle access points on Playfair Road, one on the most northern end of the Stage 2 construction zone and one on the most southern end of the Stage 2 construction zone.

Construction hours will remain 7:00am to 6:00pm Monday to Friday and 8:00am to 1:00pm on Saturdays. No works will take place on Sundays or public holidays. Thank you for your patience and consideration during this important work.
