As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild essential services, the 2023-24 Budget is delivering a historic \$1.4 billion for new and upgraded schools in regional NSW. This targeted investment in growing communities will ensure working families get access to a world class public education.

The 2023-24 Budget committed funding to progress with an upgrade to Dapto High School.

These funds will help upgrade Dapto High School by delivering new and upgraded facilities, including a new Covered Outdoor Learning Space (COLA). Further updates will be released as the project progresses.

Early planning has begun. At this stage of the project, site investigations and needs analysis are underway.

In the next stage of the project, architects and engineers will be appointed and analysis of the site take place, along with development of the concept design. Doing so means that we consider the needs of the local area now and into the future, and ensure the right school facilities are designed for the community.
