Project update | April 2024

Investing in our schools

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild essential services, the 2023-24 Budget is delivering a historic \$1.4 billion for new and upgraded schools in regional NSW. This targeted investment in growing communities will ensure working families get access to a world class public education.

Project overview

The upgrade at Dapto High School will provide a new Covered Outdoor Learning Area (COLA) to provide a shade structure to students, staff and the local community.

Progress summary

Planning and site investigations are continuing to understand the requirements for the Dapto High School upgrade. In February 2024, the project team met with Wollongong City Council to discuss planning pathways for the upgrade to address flood constraints on site.

Next steps

- finalise concept design
- finalise Development Application (DA) and lodge with Wollongong City Council
- tender for construction contract.
