Investing in our schools

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild public education, the 2025-26 Budget is delivering \$2.1 billion for new and upgraded schools in regional NSW. This targeted investment will ensure growing communities get access to a world class public education.

Project overview

The upgrade at Dapto High School will provide a new covered outdoor learning area (COLA) providing a shaded space for students, staff and the local community.

Progress update

The construction of the covered outdoor learning area (COLA) structure has been completed, and electrical and communication services have now been installed. Work is underway to install a new drainage and stormwater pit to ensure rainwater run-off from the structure is mitigated.

Next Steps

The final step before the school community can use the new COLA is to install new concrete pathways to connect with the existing pathway. It is anticipated that the school community will have access for assemblies and general recreational activities by August 2025.

The multi-purpose court will be painted during the October school holidays, as the paint used for the courts performs best when applied in warmer weather.
