Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6.7 billion over the next four years to deliver 190 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. In addition, a record \$1.3 billion is being spent on school maintenance over five years. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

Dapto Public School

A project is underway at Dapto Public School to deliver a new building that provides 20 innovative learning spaces, associated practical activity spaces and an extension to the existing library and administration facilities. This upgrade will help meet future enrolment growth in the local area.

Development application

We have submitted a Development Application (DA) to Wollongong City Council. Council has advised us that the DA will be on exhibition from 26 July to 14 August 2019.

Next steps

Subject to DA approval, works will begin in the coming months and the project is expected to be completed in early 2021.
