### Project update

#### Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6 billion over the next four years to deliver more than 170 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. In addition, a record \$1.3 billion is being spent on school maintenance over four years. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

#### Dapto Public School

A project is underway at Dapto Public School to deliver a new building that provides 20 innovative learning spaces, associated practical activity spaces, and an extension to the existing library and administration facilities.

#### Planning progress

Concept design is now complete and we continue to work closely with school stakeholders through schematic design. We anticipate schematic design to be endorsed by April 2019.

#### Next steps

Following final endorsement of the schematic design, construction tender documentation will commence.

## Frequently asked questions

### Why is Dapto Public School being upgraded?

The upgrade to Dapto Public School will provide students with innovative learning environments and cater for future growth in the area.

### What does the Dapto Public School upgrade include?

The upgraded Dapto Public School includes a new building that will deliver 20 flexible innovative learning spaces, and an expansion to the existing administration facilities (Block A) and library facilities (Block D).

### What is an innovative learning space?

Innovative learning spaces will:

- be adaptable to accommodate small or large groups
- include learning environments with flexible, adaptable spaces that help students use modern technology, while working independently and in groups
- adapt to changing technologies to meet the needs of evolving teaching techniques.

### What phase is the project in?

The project is currently in the design phase which will be completed when schematic design is endorsed.

### Will students be relocated during the upgrades?

Students will not be required to relocate during the upgrade.

### Will the demountables be removed?

Yes, the demountables will be removed when the project is completed.

### When will construction commence?

Construction works to upgrade the school are scheduled to commence late 2019 for a duration of approximately 15 months.

### When will the project be completed?

The upgrade to Dapto Public School is expected to be completed by early 2021.

### How will the community be kept informed?
