The NSW Department of Education is committed to delivering new and upgraded schools for communities across NSW. The delivery of these important projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students and supports growth in the local economy.

Dapto Public School

A project is underway at Dapto Public School to deliver a new building that provides 20 innovative learning spaces, associated practical activity spaces, an extension to the existing library and administration facilities, and a minor canteen refurbishment. This upgrade will help meet future enrolment growth in the local area and all temporary demountable buildings will be removed at the completion of the project.

Upcoming works

Throughout December 2020 and January 2021, works at Dapto Public School will include:

- major excavation, earthworks and concrete structural works, which will require excavators, diggers, concrete trucks and concrete boom pumps.
- the extension and fit out works to the administration building, library and canteen will soon start, which will include demolition works.

The movement of trucks and machinery in and out of the school will be managed by traffic control, and dust mitigation measures will be implemented.
