### Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$7 billion over the next four years, continuing its program to deliver more than 200 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

The NSW Department of Education is committed to delivering new and upgraded schools for communities across NSW. The delivery of these important projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students and supports growth in the local economy.

### **Project overview**

A project is underway to upgrade Dapto Public School to help meet future enrolment growth in the local area.

The project will deliver:

- 20 innovative learning spaces
- practical activity spaces
- an extension to the existing library and administration facilities
- minor refurbishment to the canteen.

All temporary demountable buildings will be removed at the completion of the project.

### **Progress summary**

The minor upgrade to the canteen has been completed and was occupied prior to Term 1 2021.

The extension works to the library and administration buildings are well advanced and are planned to be ready to use by Day 1 Term 2.

The remainder of the major works are progressing well and are on track to be completed by late 2021, weather dependant.

We will start to remove the demountable classrooms at the end of the project, when the new buildings are occupied. The carpark works will start following the demountable removals and is scheduled to be completed late 2021.

### Next steps

Throughout March 2021, works at Dapto Public School will include:

- extension works to the Administration and Library buildings
- major concrete pours and structural works on the new learning base building.

These activities will include concrete pumps and increased truck movement in and out of the site, which will be managed by traffic control.

Dust mitigation measures will be put in place.

Structural steel and brick works will begin on site in April. These works will require cranes to enter the project site and we will notify the community in advance.
