The NSW Department of Education is committed to delivering new and upgraded schools for communities across NSW. The delivery of these important projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students and supports growth in the local economy.

Dapto Public School

A project is underway at Dapto Public School to deliver a new building that provides 20 innovative learning spaces, associated practical activity spaces, an extension to the existing library and administration facilities, and a minor canteen refurbishment. This upgrade will help meet future enrolment growth in the local area and all temporary demountable buildings will be removed at the completion of the project.

Building work commencement

Patterson Building Group have been appointed as the principal contractor for the major works at Dapto Public School.

Next steps

October

It is anticipated that the builder will set up on site and prepare for the works to commence. These works include a site survey, set up of site facilities and amenities including site safety fencing and traffic control signage. This phase will include deliveries of temporary site buildings, and trade contractors installing fencing and the establishment of site entry/access roadway.

November

Works for this month will include demolition and site clearing works to facilitate the new building works, piling works to create the footings, major earthworks and excavation, concrete structure works, including concrete trucks and pumps. The building contractor will engage qualified traffic controllers to manage all access into the site of major machinery and trucks. The building works and site set establishment includes plans to manage dust all other relevant environmental impacts. We will continue to keep the school community and local residents informed of progress on the project.
