Works notification

The Dapto Public School upgrade is nearing completion. The project includes 20 innovative learning spaces, associated practical activity spaces and an extension to the existing library and administration facilities. This upgrade will help meet future enrolment growth in the local area.

Removal of Demountable Buildings

The contractor will start works to remove the demountable buildings in late September 2021. It is anticipated these demountable buildings will be off site by mid-October 2021, weather depending.

Works associated with the removal of the demountable buildings will include:

- plumbing works to disconnect stormwater and sewer lines connected to the buildings;
- electrical works to disconnect all power and ICT to the buildings;
- general contractors to disconnect the buildings ready for transport;
- landing on site of a large crane to facilitate the removal of buildings onto transport and
- movement of a number of trucks required to transport the buildings.

The movement of trucks and machinery in and out of the school will be managed by traffic control and dust mitigation measures will be implemented.

Remaining works

Following the removal of the demountable buildings, make good works will start, which include:

- removing all brick piers;
- removing covered walkway links and
- removing all redundant concrete paths.

In addition to the make good works, the construction of the carpark will start.
