Project summary

Stage 1 of the Darlinghurst Public School upgrade is nearing completion.

When Stage 1 has been finished, the following facilities will be available for the school to use:

- 9 new teaching and learning spaces
- 3 preschool classrooms
- A new library

Next steps

In order to limit disruption to students, the school is anticipated to move into the new facilities following the NAPLAN examinations in May 2022.

Stage 2 construction works will start after the school has moved into the new facilities delivered in Stage 1. Stage 2 will provide more new learning and teaching spaces, a new hall and canteen and covered outdoor learning areas (COLAs).
