#### Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$8.6 billion in school infrastructure over the next four years, continuing its program to deliver 160 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. This builds on the more than \$9.1 billion invested in projects delivered since 2017, a program of \$17.7 billion in public education infrastructure.

The NSW Department of Education is committed to delivering new and upgraded schools for communities across NSW. The delivery of these important projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students and supports growth in the local economy.

### **Project overview**

Darlington Public School is being upgraded to deliver new facilities and provide for growing student enrolments in the area.

#### **Progress summary**

Stage 1 of the Darlington Public School upgrade was finished in May 2022. The school has been using the new facilities including:

- 9 new teaching and learning spaces
- 3 preschool classrooms
- a new library.

Stage 2 of the project started in May 2022, with the demolition of the existing school building. Demolition has recently finished and the site sheds have been relocated. The on-site stormwater tanks and the tower crane have been installed.

- more new learning and teaching spaces
- a new hall and canteen
- covered outdoor learning areas (COLAs),
- landscaping and play areas
- new staff facilities.

This week we started the stormwater connection to the new school building. The local community has been notified and these works will be finished over the school holidays.

Over the next few months, other works will include installing the drainage and sewerage system and the cables that will carry electricity and internet services to and from the new building as well as construction of floor slabs and the walls of the new building.


