Works notification

A project is underway at Darlington Public School to deliver new facilities including learning and teaching spaces, a hall, a library, administration and staff facilities, a canteen and covered outdoor learning areas (COLAs). Main works began in March 2021 and are progressing well.

Concrete pours

Works to pour the concrete slabs for the new school building at Darlington Public School began in late April 2021, and have progressed as weather has permitted. The timeframe for the concrete pours has been extended, and is now expected to continue until early September 2021.

The work zone where the concrete pours are taking place continues to be separated from the Golden Grove Street road and footpath by barricades. There is safe pedestrian access along Golden Grove Street via the western side of the road, or via the B-Class hoarding adjacent to the work site.

Traffic management will be in place to mitigate any disruption caused by concrete trucks making deliveries along Golden Grove Street. Traffic management will manage all pedestrian and vehicular traffic whilst the concrete pours are taking place.

The concrete pours are not expected to impact drop-off and pick-up times at Darlington Public School.

We are here to make sure that work is completed safely and efficiently and we will minimise impacts on the community at every opportunity.
