Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6.7 billion over the next four years to deliver 190 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW.

In addition, a record \$1.3 billion is being spent on school maintenance over five years. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

Progress summary

Darlington Public School is being upgraded to deliver new and upgraded facilities, innovative learning spaces, and provide for growing student enrolments in the area.

The master planning, concept and schematic design phases are now complete. Throughout these phases, we have sought input from the school, its neighbours and the Darlington community across a broad range of themes and issues. This feedback has been incorporated, where appropriate, into the design.

An Aboriginal Cultural Heritage Assessment has been completed, including consultation with students, local community members and registered Aboriginal parties, such as the Local Aboriginal Land Council.

We are also working closely with the school to preserve and integrate Aboriginal artworks into the new design.

A State Significant Development application has now been lodged and is currently on exhibition.

State Significant Development (SSD) applications are used for projects that have special significance to the people and State of NSW. The Department of Planning, Industry and Environment (DPIE) is responsible for the planning approval process for SSD applications, rather than a local council.
