Works notification

A project is underway at Darlington Public School to deliver new facilities including learning and teaching spaces, a hall, a library, administration and staff facilities, a canteen and covered outdoor learning areas (COLAs). Main works began in early March 2021 and are progressing well.

Pedestrian hoarding

Pedestrian (B-Class) hoarding will be installed along the footpath at Golden Grove Street. Installation is expected to take place between 9 April 2021 and 13 April 2021. Temporary pedestrian diversions and traffic management will be in place while the hoarding modules are installed.

Tower crane installation

During main works construction, a tower crane will be established. The deconstructed crane will be delivered by trucks and installed using large mobile cranes. Installation is expected to take place on 21 April 2021, weather permitting. If weather does not permit the installation of the crane during these dates, installation may take place in the following days.

The tower crane will assist construction works and the movements of materials on site.

When not in use, the crane will be seen to weathervane, whereby the jib arm of the crane will move in the direction of the wind. This is normal operations. Appropriate controls and monitoring measures will be in place for the duration of the time the crane is on site.

No loads will be lifted over the school site, the general public or nearby neighbours.

Concrete pours

Concrete slabs for the new school building will be poured at intervals starting from late April 2021. Concrete pours will take place periodically until September 2021. More information about these concrete pours, including the dates these pours will be taking place will be communicated.

During the concrete pours, traffic management will be in place to mitigate any disruption caused by concrete trucks making deliveries along Golden Grove Street.

We are here to make sure that work is completed safely and efficiently and we will minimise impacts on the community at every opportunity.
