

# Darlington Public School

## Works notification

07 May 2021

A project is underway at Darlington Public School to deliver new facilities including learning and teaching spaces, a hall, a library, administration and staff facilities, a canteen and covered outdoor learning areas (COLAs). Main works began in early March 2021 and are progressing well.

### Removal of materials from site

Further to the works notification published on 19 March 2021, we are continuing our work to remove materials from site to address site constraints. These materials may include asbestos containing material. Throughout the movement and removal of materials, there will be continuous testing in accordance with the hygienist's recommendations.

Further to removal that has taken place from Saturday 20 March 2021, removal of asbestos containing material will continue and is expected to take place on Saturdays between Saturday 8 May 2021, and Saturday 29 May 2021, weather depending. The removal will take place during the approved construction hours of 8:00am and 1:00pm. All asbestos containing material will be removed from the site outside of school hours.

The area will be remediated in accordance with the Main Works Asbestos Management Plan, the Remediation Action Plan, the Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan and SafeWork NSW regulations. All work will be completed by licensed and accredited asbestos contractors, and monitored by occupational hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies and guidelines.

### Concrete pours

Concrete slabs for the new school building will be poured between Friday 14 May and Monday 7 June 2021, weather permitting. If weather does not permit the concrete pours to take place during these dates, the pours may take place in the days following. The work zone where the concrete pours will be taking place will be separated from the Golden Grove Street road and footpath by barricades.

During the concrete pours, traffic management will be in place to mitigate any disruption caused by concrete trucks making deliveries along Golden Grove Street. Traffic management will manage all pedestrian and vehicular traffic whilst the concrete pours are taking place, which are not expected to impact drop-off and pick-up times at Darlington Public School.
