Investing in our schools

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild public education, the 2025-26 Budget is delivering \$2.1 billion for new and upgraded schools in regional NSW. This targeted investment will ensure growing communities get access to a world class public education.

Project overview

The Kelso High Campus upgrade will deliver new, purpose-built facilities by 2027, including:

- 4 new classrooms
- a new student support hub with 3 classrooms and amenities
- 2 new multipurpose workshops
- new landscaping
- 2 new sports courts

At the Bathurst High Campus, the refurbishment of 2 toilet blocks, including new accessible toilets, is now complete and in use by the school.

Progress summary

We are currently in the process of evaluating tender submissions. The main works construction contractor is expected to be selected in the coming weeks.

Next steps

Once appointed, the contractor will finalise the designs for construction and the necessary statutory planning application will be submitted for approval.

Construction is expected to start in late 2025.
