Monitoring of kiss and drop facility effectiveness

Following the construction of Smalls Road Public School, we are undertaking monitoring to determine the effectiveness of the kiss and drop facility. To determine the effectiveness we will also be monitoring the kiss and drop at Denistone East Public School. This is done to ensure that the new facilities at Smalls Road have been implemented to best suit the local community.

The work involves monitoring the kiss and drop on Brabyn Street from 8:30am to 9:30am and 3:00pm to 4:00pm on Wednesdays until the mid-2021.

In order to carry out the monitoring, cameras have been installed on Smalls Road for the Smalls Road Public School kiss and drop and on Brabyn Street for the Denistone East Public School kiss and drop (see map overleaf for details). The cameras are used instead of a person physically being on site to monitor the performance of the kiss and drop. Rest assured that the footage is only used for determining the effectiveness of the kiss and drop and are only recording during the monitoring hours.

Determining the effectiveness of the kiss and drop was a requirement of the State Significant Development consent (SSD-8372-Mod-1) for the project.
