Project update | September 2023

Project Overview

A project is underway at Dubbo South Public School to repair Building F and rebuild Buildings G, H, I and J, which were damaged by fire in December 2021.

The project includes the delivery of the following:

- 5 general learning spaces
- special programs space, staff facilities, storage spaces and amenities.

Project summary

Building F has now been successfully repaired and is operational, and damaged Buildings H, I and J have been demolished and cleared, with temporary fencing in place to separate this work from school operations and ensure the safety of students and staff. Fire affected trees in the area have also been removed.

Other minor works that have been completed this year as part of the fire rebuild project are:

- repair of the Covered Outdoor Learning Area (COLA) and its play equipment
- replacement of the synthetic turf on the quadrangle
- repair of the damaged boundary fencing.

The following work is underway to prepare for the rebuild of Buildings G, H, I and J:

- design procurement and master planning are complete and concept design has begun
- procurement for a contractor for the building works will take place
- site investigations are currently in progress and a Project Reference Group (PRG) has been formed and operational.

Next steps

Over the coming months the team will be working on the final design, and confirming the contractor who will deliver the works. SINSW will provide project updates to the school and local community as these key tasks progress.
