Investing in our schools

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild public education, the 2024-25 Budget is delivering record education funding, including \$1.4 billion for new and upgraded schools in regional NSW. This targeted investment will ensure growing communities get access to a world-class public education.

Project overview

A project is underway at Dubbo South Public School to consolidate existing Buildings G, H, I and J, which were damaged by fire in early December 2021, into one new building.

5 new classrooms are being constructed, as well as:

- a practical activities area
- 2 special program rooms
- a staff study area
- a staff lounge with amenities, meeting space and storage facilities
- external updates including tiered seating, access ramps, car park resurfacing and landscaping.

Other minor works have been completed, including ICT infrastructure upgrades, repair of the covered outdoor learning area (COLA), replacement of synthetic turf and fence repairs.

Progress summary

We are excited to share that the new building is nearly ready for students and staff to start using. All works on the interior are now finished and the last of the furniture and equipment is being installed.

External works, including landscaping, have also recently been finished. See the next page for a link to a timelapse video showing the progress of construction on site.

Next steps

We will support the school to move into their new spaces. Staff will start using the staff areas this term and students and staff will start using the new classrooms from Day 1 Term 3 2025.
