Investing in our schools

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild public education, the 2024-25 Budget is delivering record education funding, including \$3.6 billion for new and upgraded schools in Western Sydney. This targeted investment will ensure growing communities get access to a world-class public education.

Project overview

This upgrade will replace demountable buildings with a new building that will include 6 classrooms, 2 multipurpose spaces, 2 learning commons, amenities and a covered walkway connecting the new building to the existing school.

Progress update

We have completed the initial design of the new building. Artist's impression can be seen on the next page.

The tender for construction is now closed. We anticipate that the contract will be awarded to a builder in May 2025.

Next steps

The impacts of the proposal will be assessed through a Review of Environmental Factors (REF) process.

We anticipate construction to begin mid to late 2025. We will keep the community updated on progress.
