Eastwood Public School Project update | July 2024



Investing in our schools

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild public education, the 2024-25 Budget is delivering record education funding, including \$8.9 billion for new and upgraded schools. This targeted investment will ensure growing communities get access to a world class public education.

Project overview

A project is underway to upgrade Eastwood Public School. The project will deliver a new 'homebase' building, with 9 new permanent classrooms, a new toilet block to replace an existing amenity block, and the removal of temporary classrooms.

Progress update

Construction has continued at Eastwood Public School. During Term 2, we have installed all the windows and external doors, closing the building off from the rain and wind. We have dismantled and removed the scaffold surrounding the new building, installed the cladding of the new building's façade and continued installing internal elements including insulation, electrical services, and internal plumbing.

Next steps

In Term 3, we are expecting to progress quickly, with the weather having less impact on the internal works. In the coming months we will install internal walls and ceilings, flooring, joinery and fittings like toilets and basins, as well as connecting services like plumbing, electricity and internet services.

We will also begin external works in preparation for the new pavement, soft fall, synthetic grass and landscaping.





School holiday works- Preparing for external works

In the upcoming school holidays, the building contractor will begin preparations to deliver the external parts of the project, which will include new soft fall, synthetic grass and landscaping to the area surrounding the new building. See map below.

These works include:

- moving the site offices and lunchrooms into the lower level of the new building
- removing site sheds and adjusting the site fencing
- moving the workers portable bathrooms to the rear of the construction site.


