Eastwood Public School project overview

Plans have been approved for the NSW Government's upgrade at Eastwood Public School.

The project will deliver nine new permanent innovative and flexible learning spaces in a new home base building.

The old toilet block will be demolished and replaced with new facilities.

Nine demountable classrooms will be removed after completion of the project. This will increase the amount of open play space at the school.

A map detailing the scope of the construction works is attached.

Progress summary

The development application (DA) has been approved by Ryde Council allowing construction activities for the Eastwood Public School upgrade to start once a contractor is appointed.

The approval considers feedback gathered throughout the DA exhibition stage and plans adapted to ensure the privacy of neighbours is adhered to.

Next steps

A construction tender has been issued and following selection of a preferred building contractor, construction is expected to start in late 2021.

The community will be notified ahead of works starting and School Infrastructure NSW will provide regular progress updates.
