An upgrade will soon be underway at Eastwood Public School. The project will deliver nine new permanent teaching spaces in a new homebase building and a new toilet block.

Progress summary

A development application (DA) has been lodged with Ryde Council, to seek development consent for the new building.

Council will place the DA on public exhibition and advise nearby property owners and residents.

Next steps

Following detailed design, a request for tender to construct the new building will be prepared in the coming months. Construction works would not begin until the outcome of the DA is known.
