Summer holidays works notification | 13 December 2022

Construction of a new multipurpose hall at Engadine High School is underway. The hall will include a full basketball court, stage, amenities, and sports and performance storage.

Building works will be taking place at Engadine High School across the Summer School Holidays

Construction and maintenance works on the new multipurpose hall will continue to take place across summer period when the school is not attended by students or staff.

Construction works taking place from mid-December 2022 will continue through to the end of the summer school holidays in late January 2023. These works across this normally quiet period will see additional trades people, trade vehicles, and possibly some additional noise on and around the school site.

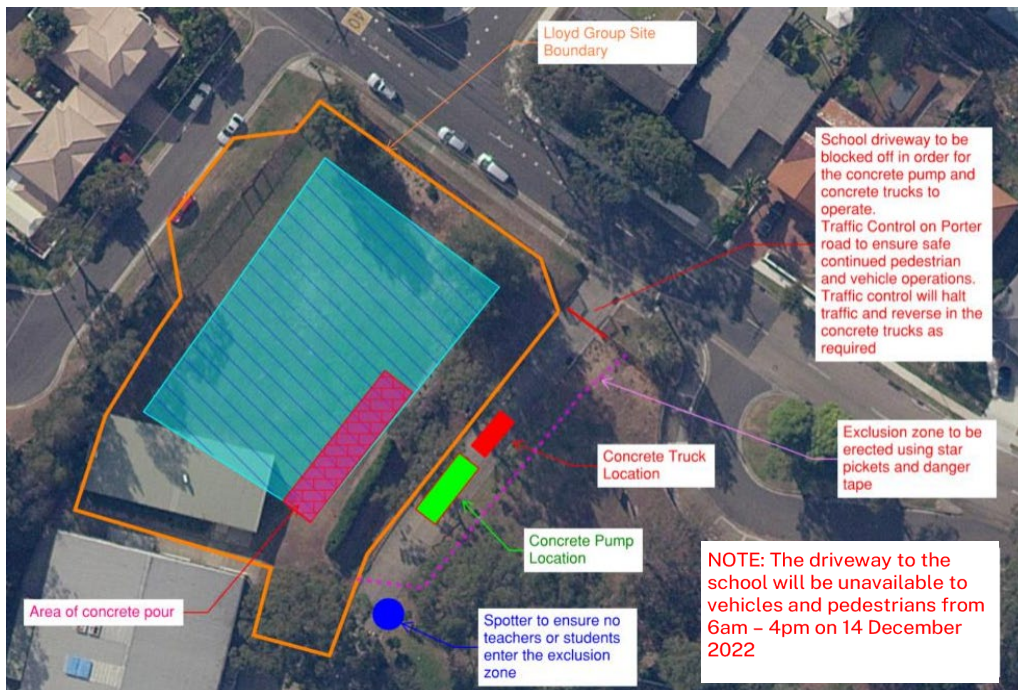
These works include, but are not limited to the following:

- concrete pour for communications room which will take place adjacent to the driveway
- repair to damaged wall at entry to school driveway
- repair to turf damaged during construction adjacent to school driveway.

School Infrastructure NSW have plans that outline the likely impacts of the upgrade works on the local community, such as noise, vibration, dust, and traffic changes. We will notify our neighbours before any disruptive work takes place.
