### Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$8.6 billion in school infrastructure over the next four years, continuing its program to deliver 160 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. This builds on the more than \$9.1 billion invested in projects delivered since 2017, a program of \$17.7 billion in public education infrastructure.

The NSW Department of Education is committed to delivering new and upgraded schools for communities across NSW. The delivery of these important projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students and supports growth in the local economy.

# **Project overview**

School Infrastructure NSW (SINSW) is building a new multipurpose hall at Engadine High School. The hall will include a full basketball court, stage, amenities, and sports and performance storage.

### Revised project timeline

COVID-19 and inclement weather have significantly impacted construction progress. As a result, SINSW has revised the completion date for the new hall at Engadine High School to early 2023. There is no operational impact to Engadine High School and all noisy works have been suspended to ensure that there is no impact to students during HSC exam periods.

### **Progress**

Wet weather continues to disrupt progress at Engadine High School. Additionally, all noisy works have been suspended to ensure that there is no impact to students during HSC exam periods.
