

Engadine High School

Works notification

September 2022

Dear resident,

In early October 2022, we will be pouring concrete and installing steel as part of the new hall build at Engadine High School. There will be increased truck movements around the site during this period.

On Friday 07 October 2022, weather permitting, builders will pour the ground floor concrete slab. One concrete pump and boom will sit in Birok Avenue and one will sit in the school driveway.

Concrete trucks will queue along Birok Avenue and Porter Road throughout the day to deliver concrete to the pumps, which will disrupt access to residential driveways. Traffic control personnel and signage will be in place to direct road and pedestrian traffic around the work zone.

From Monday 10 October 2022, weather permitting, the builder will start to deliver, unload and erect structural steel for the new hall. A mobile crane will sit next to the concrete slab and lift the steel beams off flat-bed trucks. These trucks may need to park in Birok Avenue temporarily.

In the event of poor weather conditions, the above works will be rescheduled to a later date.

Working hours

Working hours are Monday to Friday, 7 am to 5 pm and Saturday, 8am to 3pm. No work will occur on Sundays or public holidays, unless otherwise advised.
