Project overview

School Infrastructure NSW is building a new multipurpose hall at Engadine High School. The hall will include a full basketball court, stage, amenities, and sports and performance storage.

Progress summary

While there have been some delays during 2022 due to unfavourable weather events, recent months have seen some significant progress with key areas of the build being completed. These include:

- the main concrete slab for the foundations of the school hall and communications room has been poured
- installation of structural steel, roofing works, wall sheeting and façade works.

Next steps

Lloyd Group is currently engaged by the Department of Education to deliver Engadine High School Hall, and as you may be aware have recently gone into administration halting all construction at Engadine High School.

Deloitte has been appointed as the administrators and School Infrastructure NSW are currently working with the administrators to understand any implications to the project timeline and costs and will keep the school communities updated with any information as and when it becomes available. SINSW will work with the administrators to ensure that the project is delivered with minimal disruption to the school community.
