## Project update | February 2023

### Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$8.6 billion in school infrastructure over the next four years, continuing its program to deliver 160 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. This builds on the more than \$9.1 billion invested in projects delivered since 2017, a program of \$17.7 billion in public education infrastructure.

The NSW Department of Education is committed to delivering new and upgraded schools for communities across NSW. The delivery of these important projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students and supports growth in the local economy.

### Project overview

School Infrastructure NSW (SINSW) is building a new multipurpose hall at Engadine High School. The hall will include a full basketball court, stage, amenities, and sports and performance storage.

### Progress

During November and December 2022, the following work took place:

- main concrete slab for foundations of the school hall poured
- installation of structural steel
- concrete slab poured for communications room.

### Next Steps

During December and January across the summer holidays, the builder has continued to progress:

- roofing works
- wall sheeting and façade works.

These ongoing works across the summer period will ensure the delivery of the hall for students, staff, and the local community.
