
Engadine High School upgrade Works notification | November 2023

School Infrastructure NSW is building a new multipurpose hall at Engadine High School. The hall will include a full basketball court, stage, amenities, and sports and performance storage.

Traffic control in place on Friday 17 November on Birok Ave

As you may be aware from our latest project update, Stephen Edwards Constructions have been appointed as the builder to complete the remaining construction of the Engadine High School upgrade.

As part of works to reestablish the site a new site shed will be delivered via Birok Ave on between 9.30am to 12.30pm, Friday 17 November, weather permitting. Traffic control will be in place for the safety of students, staff and community, and there will be no impact to residents or visitors who wish to park on the street.

Works will restart onsite from Thursday 16 November. We are expecting to complete the remaining works to finalise the new multipurpose hall by mid-2024, subject to weather conditions.
